

PGA donates to book drive

The Glendover/Julius Marks Family Resource Center and the Lansdowne Family Resource Center received 341 books and \$165 from the Professional Golfers Association of America (PGA) during their spring meeting. Krista R. Mason and Temicula Allen thanked the PGA and accepted the contributions.

The annual book drive, which began in 2003, has brought in about 1,000 books to benefit Fayette County schoolchildren.
