

## **Lafayette junior is second in photo-essay contest**

**Curtis Northcutt**, a junior at Lafayette High School, garnered second place in the 2008 Photo-Essay Competition sponsored by Preservation Kentucky Inc. and the Kentucky Heritage Council. His entry featured Julia R. Ewan Elementary School.

In addition, Lafayette snared the Outstanding Participation Award. With 62 students competing, Lafayette had more entries than any other school.

“A lot of different things were addressed. It was pretty neat,” said Susannah Kilbourne, an English teacher, who said that her students examined everything from industrial buildings to historic homes as they explored this year’s theme: Restore-Reuse-Recycle.
