

Glendover kids adopt three pandas!

As a special project for Earth Day last spring, second-graders in Ann Preston's class at Glendover Elementary collected Pennies for Pandas. From April through the end of school, some kids brought in loose change while others did extra chores at home to earn money. The whole school was encouraged to join in the project through announcements on the daily morning show. The students sent \$128.57 to the World Wildlife Fund in Washington D.C. In return, three pandas in the Schezuan province of China (the area recently affected by an earthquake) were adopted by the children. Pennies for Pandas might become a schoolwide effort at Glendover this year.
