

Schools are encouraged to take up 'Cans for Cash' challenge

Students across Fayette County are invited to join in the U.S. Mayors' National City Recycling Challenge, also known as the Cans for Cash contest.

The contest, which runs through October, challenges cities to collect and recycle aluminum beverage cans. The schools that gather the highest number of cans per student in their school's size category will be awarded a share of \$9,000 in cash prizes.

The effort is coordinated by The Bluegrass Partnership for a Green Community, which was founded by the Urban County Government, Fayette County Public Schools and the University of Kentucky, with help from Bluegrass PRIDE and other community partners.
