

## **Students put projects on display at STLP Showcase**

A handful of local schools participated in the STLP Fall Showcase held recently at the University of Kentucky, and a few projects rated high enough to land a spot in May's state competition.

- Bryan Station High School – Three projects advanced: solar power, uber geek video and hydrogen as a fuel source.
- Paul Laurence Dunbar High School – going green and reducing carbon footprints.
- Eastside Technical Center – Two projects: Society of Automotive Technicians community service project and a robotics game.
