

62 local students named 2009 Governor's Scholars

The Governor's Scholars Program is a five-week, residential summer program for outstanding Kentucky students completing their junior year in high school. Established in 1983, the program provides academic and personal growth through the balance of a strong liberal arts program with a full co-curricular and residential life experience. Students must complete an application and compete with others from across the state. Those selected attend the program free of charge.

Each school district is responsible for sending its nominees to the state level, and most often, this competition is very competitive. At the state level, typically about 1,900 applications are received and 1,100 are selected to participate.
