

## **High school students recognized nationally**

The mission of the National Spanish Examination is to recognize student achievement and to promote language proficiency in the study of the Spanish language. The exam is an online, standardized assessment tool given voluntarily by over 3,000 teachers throughout the United States to measure proficiency and achievement of students who are studying Spanish as a second language. Last year, more than 106,000 students took the test.

**Henry Clay High School** students scored well on the exam. **Ethan Golding, Connor Callaway** and **Daniel Webb** received gold certificates for scoring in the top 5 percent nationally. **April Dodd** and **Jose Martin** received silver certificates for scoring in the top 15 percent nationally and **Rachel Looff** and **Maite Perez** received a bronze certificate for scoring in the top 25 percent nationally.
